What's New in Version 2.2.900?

Version 2.2.900 includes an important update to make QCBD compatible with international date and time settings. In addition 31 enhancements and bug fixes incorporated into QCBD since the initial release of the last version.

1. General – applies to all modules

1	IMPORTANT BUG FIX: QCBD is now compatible with international date and time settings. Prior to this release, in systems where the date format may vary between client machines, queries can return incorrect results if dates and times are included in the query criteria (for example one user uses the US date format mm/dd/yy and another user uses the international date format dd.mm.yy). This version release will now accommodate all date /time formats specified in the client Windows set up and customers may have client machines with a variety of date/time formats.
2	Feature Enhancement: Users cannot VOID a record if there are pending approvals. Pending approvals can be cancelled and then the record can be voided.
3	Feature Enhancement: All QCBD Reports – the PRINT command will now display a standard Windows printer selection dialog box allowing the user to select alternative printer and specify which pages to print.
4	Feature Enhancement: Modifications have been made to be compatible with and take advantages of Office 2010 functionality.
5	Bug Fix: Sub File Attachment Check out / Check in / cancel Check out. If user selected CANCEL the checkout was incorrectly cancelled (error). This has now been fixed.
6	Bug Fix: Additional tweaks have been made to ensure compatibility with Office 2010.
7	Feature Enhancement: All reports. For users with the PDF Add-in license, you can now select the PDF995 printer as one of the printer options and the report will be converted to PDF format without the Software995 advertisement screen being displayed.
8	Bug Fix: Change History field names sometimes referred to the system defined field name and not the user defined field name.
9	Bug Fix: Pareto Reports have been reformatted to landscape layout with enlarged graph and more room for field descriptions.

2. Corrective and Preventive Actions

10	Bug Fix: Preventive Action hard reports did not include the investigation status field on the report. This has now been added to the report.
11	Bug Fix: CAPA Reports - Labels for Field Approvals and Dates were not printed with user selected description but instead defaulted to the systems assign label descriptions. User was not able to assign these field labels in the Module layout screen. This has now been fixed.

3. Equipment Management

12	Bug Fix: Sort order of report would only accept the first sort selection in query window. This has been fixed to permit cascading sorting levels against selected query fields.
13	Bug Fix: When selecting Calibration Standards if 'Use Outside CAL Service' was set to NO (i.e. use in house calibration) a message popped up incorrectly stating allowed only if calibration was in-house. This has been fixed.

14	Bug Fix: Equipment Report always shows CALBRATE INHOUSE=YES regardless of the setting on the form. This has been fixed.

4. Master List

15	Feature Enhancement: Change Orders - when Hold for Training is selected if training is not complete, user now has the option to advance the Change Order to Release with training incomplete.
16	Feature Enhancement: User defined multi-list boxes are now sizeable. (Same as User defined text boxes and User defined single-list boxes.)
17	Feature Enhancement: When creating New Change order from Master list screen, then Change Order is now opened in the EDIT mode.
18	Feature Enhancement: When creating a new Change Order, if the new revision has not been assigned, a warning is displayed to the user when the SAVE command is selected.
19	Bug Fix: When creating a Change Order, if Advanced Change Control was turned on and a default Change Coordinator assigned, the default change coordinator was not added to the change order as expected. This has been fixed.
20	Bug Fix: When adding a document to a change order, if the transaction failed, the document could not be deleted.

5. Supplier Management

21	Bug Fix: Supplier Report - If the Evaluation Last date Done and Next date Due was NA, the report still showed a date and was set incorrectly as OVERDUE. This has been fixed.
22	Bug Fix: The NCMR History and Vendor CAR History report should not include NCMRs or CAR which have been voided.

6. Training Management

23	Bug Fix: Training Reports: Reports with queries that contain Linked NCMRs, CAPAs, Complaints or Deviations as part of the query criteria did not return all expected training results. This has been fixed.
24	Bug Fix: The training record NEXT DUE date was not always updated correctly when there were changes made to the employees training profile (department, position or job function changes). This has now been corrected.
25	Bug Fix: All training overdue reports from all sources (dashboard view, Overdue report and Advanced Training Analysis, etc) are now synchronized to match.
26	Feature Enhancement: When adding Department, Position or Job Function for an employee, you were limited to 50 entries each. Limit has now been raised list limits to 200 entries each.
27	Feature Enhancement: When viewing the employee's individual training profile, the training records are not displayed and sorted according to the user's selections made on the screen.
28	Feature Enhancement: Training Matrix and configuration screen. The Matrix and Definitions lists now have filter options for easier search and viewing.
29	Feature Enhancement: Training Matrix and configuration screen. The Matrix and Definitions lists can now be exported to Excel for further analysis.
30	Feature Enhancement: Employee Training profile screen. The Training Records and Training Plans lists now have filter options for easier search and viewing.
31	Feature Enhancement: Employee Training profile screen. The Training Records and Training Plans lists can now be exported to Excel for further analysis.
